Trial Entry

Your dog **MUST** have a Rodeo Dog registration number through secreterrier.com to enter.

Trials will be limited to 25 entries per class.

Late and Day of Show entries will be accepted as room permits

Regular entry fee - \$15 per class

Late/Day of show entry allowed if class limit isn't reached – \$20 per class

FEO entries will be accepted, same fees as above.

Move ups will be accepted

Cancellations:

Entry fees will not be refunded if a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee.

Entry fees will not be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fires, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Full refund minus \$3 administrative fee/run for cancellations up to 5pm July 31, 2026.

No refunds for cancellations after 5pm July 31, 2026 except for injured dogs. In this case, a veterinarian's note is required to receive a refund and will be minus a \$4 administrative fee/run.

Straight Line – Beginner, Performance (3 runs of each)

Clover – Beginner, Performance (3 runs of each)

Round Up – Performance (3 runs of each)

Lock, Stock & Barrel – Performance (3 runs of each)

Daily Schedule: Check-ins will begin at 9:30 am

Briefing and First Walk Throughs 9:45 am

AWARDS

Ribbons will be awarded for dogs placing 1st -3rd place. All qualifying scores will receive a qualifying flat ribbon. Title ribbons will be awarded for any titles earned.

Notice to Exhibitors

Any dog of any breed or mix may participate. Dogs under 6 months old are eligible to participate in Beginner Classes ONLY. Dogs 6 months of age and older are eligible to participate in any of the Classes.

Blind, deaf, and handicapped dogs are eligible to compete. Note any accommodation needed in your trial entry.

Bitches in season MUST run last at the end of the trial for all classes and levels. You MUST notify the trial secretary two (2) days prior to trial if the participating bitch is in season.

Dogs that measure 12" and under will be considered small, dogs that measure over 12" - 18" will be considered medium, and dogs that measure over 18" will be considered large. Measurement is on your honor; however, the judge reserves the right to measure the dog if there is question.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs.

NOTE: we will do our best to accommodate all reactive / non-aggressive (human or animal) dogs – but this is not guaranteed. The building has been intentionally set up to accommodate extra space for ALL dogs. It is up to the handler to advocate for their dog's needs.

Owners are responsible for errors made on entry forms, whoever may have made such errors. Please check your confirmation carefully and make sure your information has been recorded correctly.

Do Over Dog Training reserves the right to refuse any entry. You will be notified by email, and your entry fee will be returned.

All dogs must always be on leash except during their scheduled run in the ring. Flexi leads are not allowed on the trial site. See Rodeo Dog Rules & Regulations for appropriate collars in the ring. There are no minimum/maximum leash requirements for beginner level classes.

Rodeo Dog Event Waiver and Release of Liability

I acknowledge that participation in a Rodeo Dog event involves inherent risks, including but not limited to injury to myself, my dog, other persons, or property. I voluntarily assume all risks associated with participation in this event.

I agree that Rodeo Dog Company and Do Over Dog Training, along with their owners, instructors, members, volunteers, and judges, shall not be held liable for any injury, personal injury, loss, or damage to any person, dog, or property that may occur as a result

of participation in this event or presence on the premises. This includes, but is not limited to, injury caused by any dog, including my own, as well as injuries that may occur on the premises.

I accept full responsibility for the actions and behavior of my dog at all times. I agree to indemnify and hold harmless Rodeo Dog Company and Do Over Dog Training from any and all claims, demands, damages, or causes of action arising out of or related to my participation or my dog's participation in this event.

I certify that my dog is in good health and is not aggressive toward people or other dogs. I agree to comply with all event rules and regulations.

In the event of dangerous weather conditions or other unforeseen circumstances, Rodeo Dog Company and Do Over Dog Training reserve the right to cancel or modify the event. Refunds, if any, will be issued at the discretion of the event organizers.
